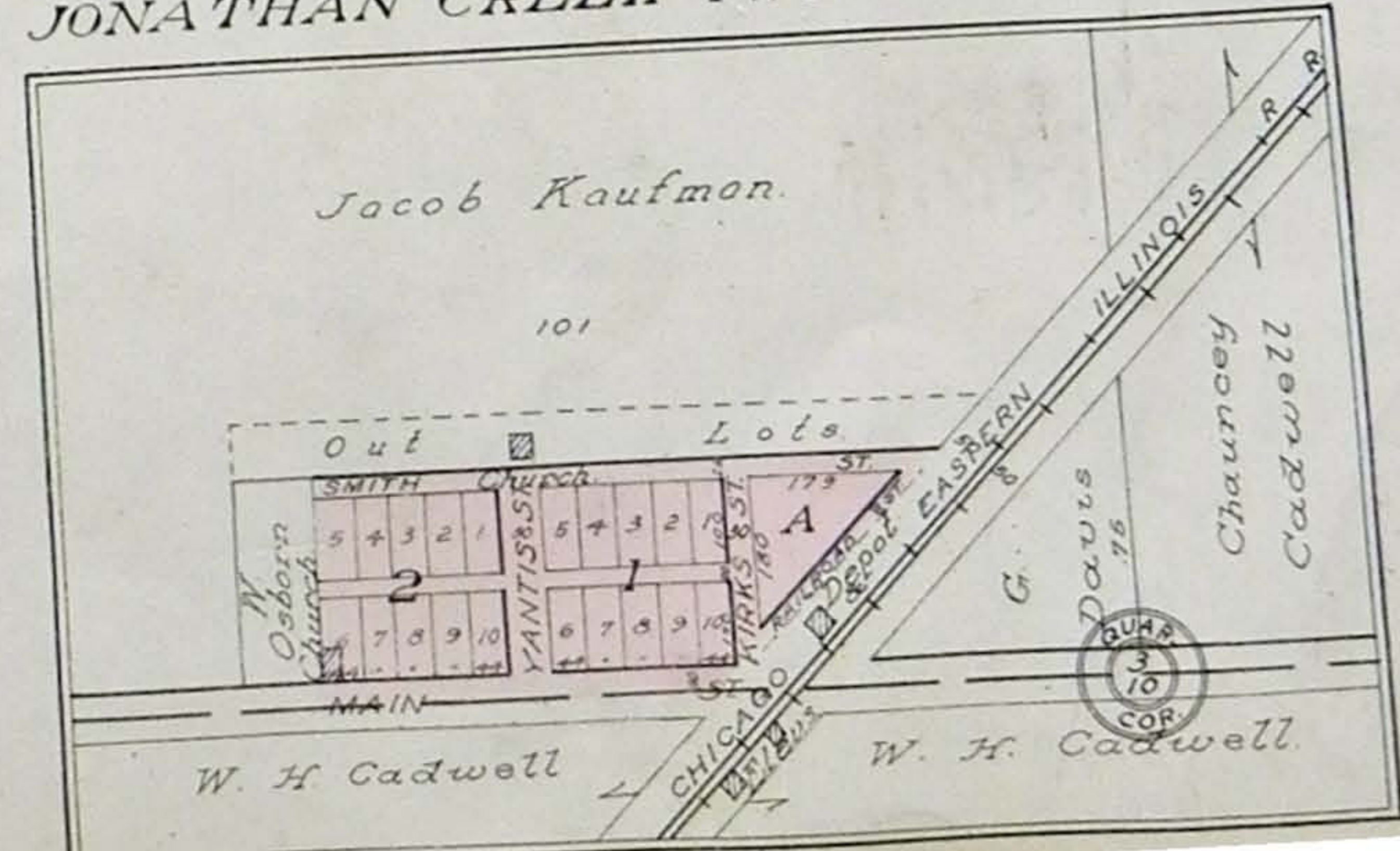
MAP OF WHITLEY TOWNSHIP

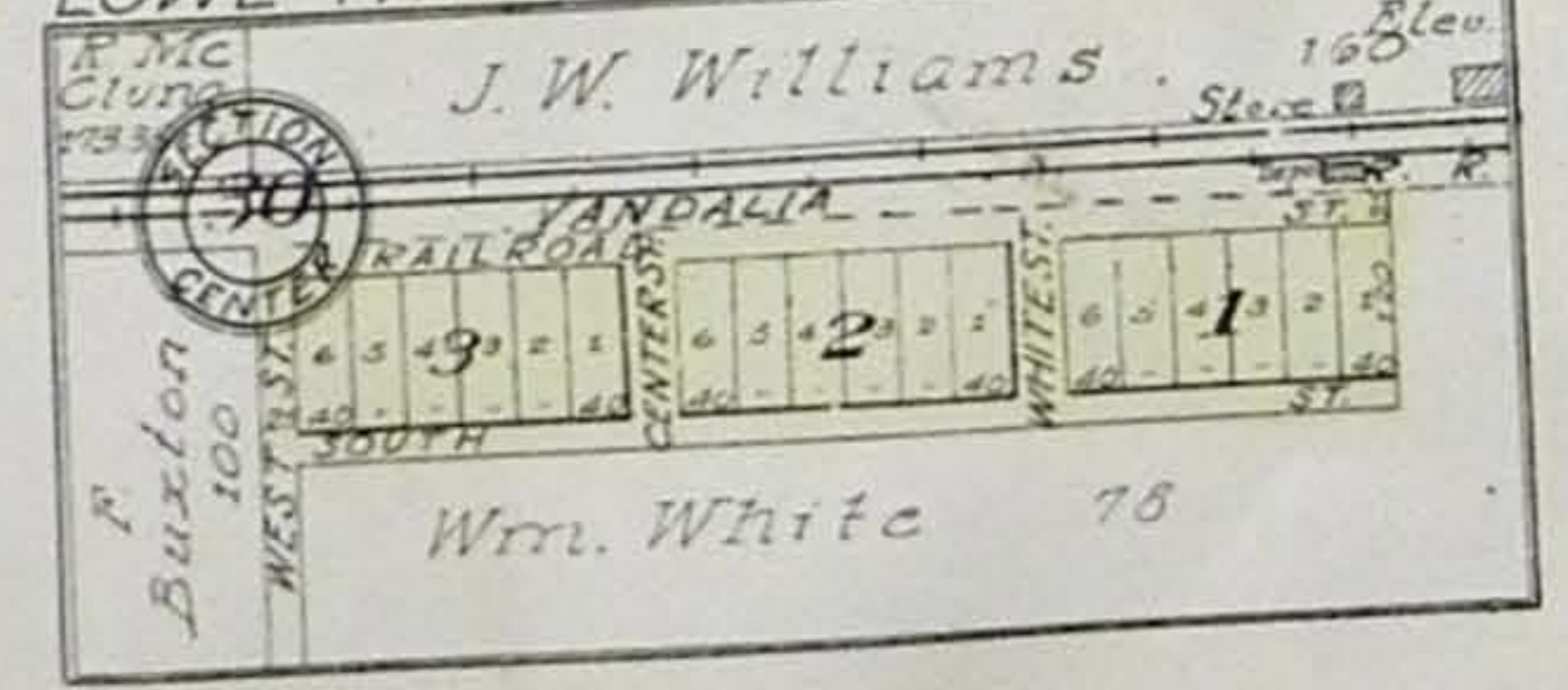

 Diamond, Jacob H., was born in Steuben County, New York, March 18, 1835, and came to Illinois with his parents when he was but five years old, settling near Paris, Edgar County, where they resided for a number of years on a farm. Here he grew to manhood and although educational advantages were not of the best, he acquired a good practical education. His father died in 1850 and he assumed the responsibilities and cares of the family as a father. He moved from Edgar County to Oakland, Coles County, and engaged in a saw and grist mill for a period of four years. He then moved to Verdun, Moultrie County where he erected another mill, which he operated for about two years when he traded his machinery for 120 acres of land near Oakland. He farmed this for three years and then traded his Coles County farm for 160 acres in Lowe Township, Moultrie County, where he lived until 1886, when he retired from active farming and moved to Sullivan, having acquired by his untiring energy and business foresight 900 acres of land in a body. He was married to Miss Elizabeth Kerns, of Oakland, Coles County, Nov. 19, 1859. To this union were born three children. Mrs. Diamond died on June 16, 1869. His second marriage was to Mrs. Elizabeth Hunsinger of White County, Ill., whose death occurred July 15, 1885. To this union was born one child, now Mrs. T. P. Ellis, of near Lovington. His third marriage was to Mrs. Lydia Smith of Lovington in 1892, who with his two daughters, Mrs. Arabella Ellis and Mrs. Hattie Randolph, survive him. He died April 16, 1912.

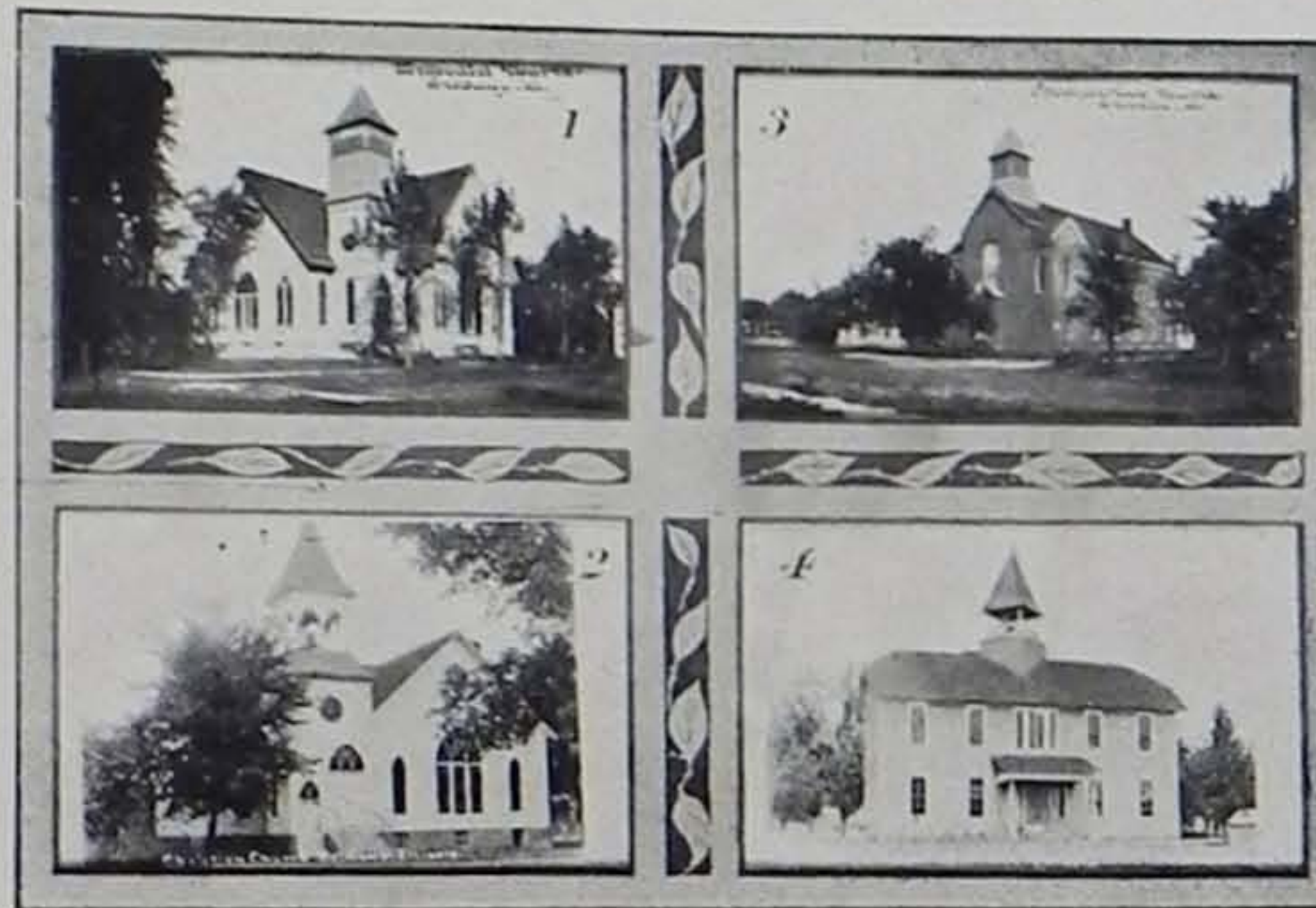

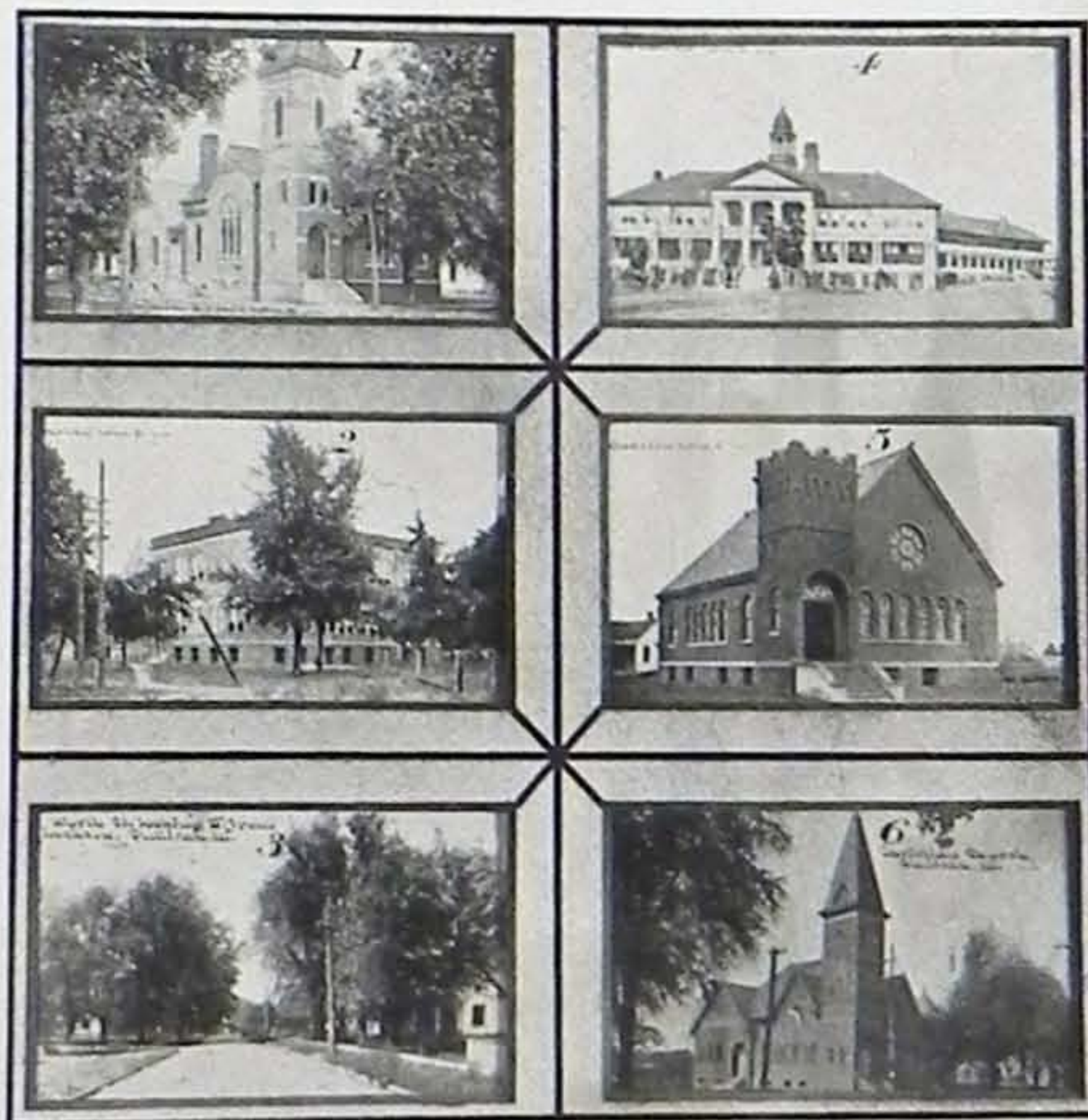
